Dear Ms. Gonzalez:

On June 6, 2008, you filed on behalf of ISO New England, Inc. (ISO-NE), a notice of withdrawal of certain tariff sheets¹ that were inadvertently included in its Order No. 890-A² compliance filing on April 15, 2008. You state that these tariff sheets, which describe how ISO-NE will process a request to cluster studies and structure transmission customers' obligations when they have joined a cluster, should have been submitted as part of its Order No. 890 compliance filing in Docket No. ER08-54-001.³ Pursuant to the

authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs & Market Development – East under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your notice of withdrawal is accepted for filing.

Notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests and interventions due on or before June 27, 2008. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your ISO-NE.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
