ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO RESCHEDULE PREHEARING CONFERENCE

(Issued July 14, 2008)

1. On July 11, 2008, the New England Power Pool Participants Committee (“NEPOOL”) filed a motion to reschedule the prehearing conference in the above-captioned proceeding to Thursday, July 17, 2008. In its motion, NEPOOL explained that on July 22, 2008, several of the parties actively participating in this proceeding will be attending a two-day joint meeting of two NEPOOL technical committees that cannot be rescheduled at this point. Rescheduling the prehearing conference would allow a number of key members and support personnel who are necessary or important support for maximizing the productivity of the prehearing conference to participate in person.
2. NEPOOL also states in its motion that it has contacted representatives for all of the parties in this proceeding, and there are no objections to rescheduling the prehearing conference to July 17, 2008.
3. Accordingly, NEPOOL’s motion to reschedule the prehearing conference is granted. The prehearing conference scheduled for Tuesday, July 22, 2008, is hereby cancelled.
4. The prehearing conference will be rescheduled for Thursday, July 17, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. in a hearing room of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426, to establish a procedural schedule in this case, to clarify the positions of the participants, and to discuss such other and further matters as may be necessary and appropriate. In this regard, the participants are expected to have exchanged proposals prior to the scheduled prehearing conference and are required to submit to me on or before July 16, 2008, a proposed procedural schedule which accords

with the Commission's Order requiring an Initial Decision by April 1, 2009, or a proposal for an expedited procedural schedule.
